Important Information About SAM.GOV Changes

For years, PTACs have made efforts to help keep their clients safe in the Government marketplace. One of the repeated problems PTACs across the nation have warned their clients about is paying third-party companies a fee for registration in the SAM.GOV database. Here are three important things you should know.

- 1. Registration in SAM.GOV is free.
- 2. If you need assistance with registration in SAM.GOV, your NJIT PTAC counselor can assist you at no cost.
- 3. It can be dangerous to provide your banking information to third parties or allow them the opportunity to re-route your payments.

Case in point. The General Services Administration is currently investigating fraud within the SAM.GOV database and is now requiring new contractors registering in SAM to "submit a notarized letter identifying the authorized entity administrators associated with the contractor's DUNS Number," according to a recent article published on Fedscoop.com.

Recommended Action from GSA for all Entities Registered in SAM.GOV:

"Entities registered in SAM are advised to log into SAM and review their registration information, particularly their financial information. Contact the supporting Federal Service Desk at www.fsd.gov, or by telephone at 866-606-8220 (toll-free) or 334-206-7828 (internationally), for FREE assistance, Entities are responsible for ensuring that their information is current and correct in SAM in accordance with paragraph (b) of FAR clause 52.232-33, and should routinely review such information for accuracy."

Contact your NJIT PTAC representative if you have concerns, questions, or need assistance with any issues related to SAM.GOV.

Bottom Line: It is unclear from the articles published above whether the SAM.GOV was breached, or the issue stems from businesses allowing third-party entities to enter data in their SAM.GOV profile. Regardless, we highly advise that you keep your SAM.GOV registration in-house and administered by a trusted owner or employee of the company.

Supporting Your Market Research Efforts

Trying to use some of the federal government's free websites for market research, but still finding yourself challenged to put the pieces together? Or perhaps you're having a hard time understanding some of the codes and jargon contained within the data.

It is always a great idea to meet with your PTAC counselor ahead of your agency meetings for tips on what to do and what to avoid, in addition to getting the inside scoop on the agency before your meeting.

Client Prerequisites:

Any business seeking to become an NJIT PTAC client must meet the following requirements:

- 1. New Jersey-based small business (excluding Union County businesses)
- 2. Established at least two years
- 3. Customer base that demonstrates past performance
- 4. Must not be delinquent with child support or taxes
- 5. Creditworthy
- Business bank account

- 8. Company website and email preferred
