Twenty years later Kurt retired, and Dieter purchased his shares.

Dieter married his wife Eleanor in 1968 and also started his college education at NJIT in the evenings, graduating in 1976, with a BS degree in Industrial Engineering.

More than 50 years since its inception, the Weiss-Aug Group is a subcontractor to medical, automotive, and electronic industries, manufacturing complex precision stamped, machined, molded components and assemblies. The Company's headquarters are in New Jersey and today Weiss-Aug has six manufacturing plants and a research and development laboratory. The plants are located in New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Colorado and Mexico and they employ over 700 people.
