

CAMPUS ADVISORS FOR THE STUDENT CONDUCT PROCESS

What is a Campus Advisor?

Students and complainants may request the assistance of a Campus Advisor throughout the Student Conduct Process. Campus Advisors are volunteers who have been trained and are knowledgeable about the student conduct policies and procedures. They can help parties navigate each stage of the process, providing valuable guidance and support.

How a Campus Advisor Can Help You:

- ✓ Advisors can provide moral support and help students and complainants understand what to expect during meetings.
- ✓ Advisors help students and complainants understand the Student Conduct Process and Code of Student Conduct.
- ✓ Advisors can assist in preparing for conduct meetings and hearings. They may also accompany parties to meetings and disciplinary proceedings.
- ✓ Advisors can provide general guidance on potential outcomes and next steps. They can also help connect students with campus resources.

What is the Role of the Campus Advisor?

The role of a Campus Advisor is to support the student or complainant, not to help them avoid accountability. Advisors may not speak for or represent students or complainants.

Am I required to have a Campus Advisor?

No. Parties are not required to have a Campus Advisor, and may select another NJIT faculty or staff member to serve as their advisor (even if the person is not on the list of trained campus advisors).

Who can serve as a Campus Advisor?

A Campus Advisor is a member of the NJIT community (e.g., staff, faculty) who can help the student or complainant navigate the disciplinary system. Except where required by law, family members and attorneys are not eligible to serve as Campus Advisors.

Contacting an Advisor:

If you want to request the assistance of one of the trained Campus Advisors, you can contact any of the listed Campus Advisors directly by email. Be sure to reach out as early as possible to schedule a meeting and find out if they are available to assist you.

Please note: If a particular advisor cannot assist you, or you cannot reach a particular advisor, continue to contact the other individuals on the list.
