IMPORTANCE OF NJIT'S NEW STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

On the first day of classes, you will receive an email with more information on how to complete NJIT's New Student Requirements. These must be finished during your first semester at NJIT, but we recommend completing the modules during your first week before you get busy with classwork!



SEND YOUR AP/IB SCORES AND TRANSFER CREDITS

If you have AP test scores, IB credits, and/or college transfer credits, please request the official scores or transcripts be sent to NJIT's Admissions Office (admissions@njit.edu) so the credit evaluation process can begin. As this will impact your first semester schedule, do not wait on sending this over so NJIT has the most accurate information.

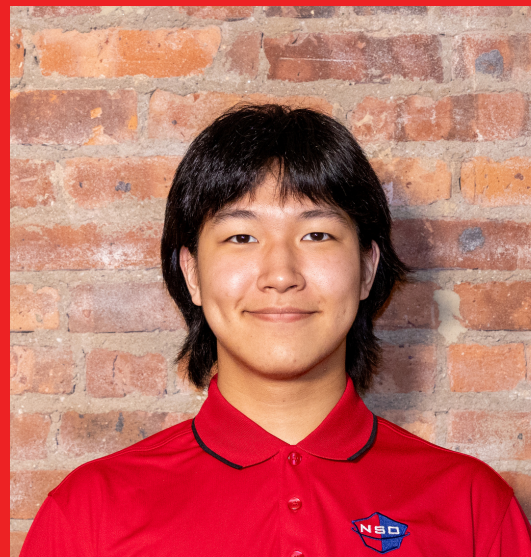
Student Health Packet Reminder
