

## Office of the Registrar Request to Change Student Legal Name

All requests to change legal names must include documentation substantiating the legal change of name. This documentation may be in the form of a court order, birth certificate, passport, naturalization certificate, marriage license or other documentation accepted at the discretion of NJIT. Your request for a legal name change cannot be made without the required documentation.

Legal name changes cannot be processed for students who are no longer enrolled as active students at NJIT. Academic records must reflect the name used while in attendance at NJIT, however, a notation will be made on the transcript that the name has been changed since leaving NJIT. New diplomas cannot be issued when the legal name change has taken place after graduation.

If you wish to order a replacement diploma after a legal name change, please submit a Request for Replacement Diploma form.
